

OUT OF HOURS NOTICE

ALINGA STREET TO ELOUERA GOULD INTERSECTIONS - NORTHBOURNE AVENUE

12 - 22 JUNE 2018

Canberra's first stage of Light Rail is progressing and construction is well underway. This is an exciting time in our City and Canberra Metro is working hard to see this vision come to life.

Construction Works:

To avoid traffic disruption during the day, the following works will be completed out-of-hours:

- Transfer of an oversize steel canopy from the Elouera-Gould intersection to Alinga Street light rail stop;
- Installation of steel canopy on site at the Alinga Street light rail stop.

The hours of work will be from **8:00pm to 6:00am from Tuesday 12 June to Friday 22 June.**

Traffic Management:

Traffic management will be in place and highly visible throughout the works.

- Closure of fast and middle lanes (northbound only) along Northbourne Avenue from Elouera-Gould Streets intersection to the Alinga Street intersection for transfer of an oversize steel canopy;
- Closure of Alinga Street after 11pm to allow for oversize steel canopy to be installed (one night).

NO CHANGE to southbound traffic movement on Northbourne Avenue.

Additional Information:

The equipment that will be used includes: lifting cranes, excavators, elevated work platforms, trucks and light vehicles.

Due to the nature of the work, some of the activities will be noisy. The project team will limit noise impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used* and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
