

OUT OF HOURS NOTICE

GUNGAHLIN, MANNING CLARK, MAPLETON AVENUE, NULLABOR AND WELL STATION STOPS ALL SUNDAYS FROM 2 SEPTEMBER - 28 OCTOBER 2018

Canberra's first stage of Light Rail is progressing and construction is well underway. This is an exciting time in our City and Canberra Metro is working hard to see this vision come to life.

Construction Works:

Due light rail vehicle testing along the corridor of a week day, additional Sunday day works are required to complete general finishing works at light rail stops along Flemington Road. Works including carpentry, concreting and steel fixing will occur every Sunday day until 28 October.

Traffic Management and Detours:

There will be NO DISRUPTION to traffic along Flemington Road.

Additional Information:

The equipment used includes: road and demolition saw, angle grinder, watercart, crane trucks and light vehicles.

Due to the nature of the work, some of the activities will be noisy. The project team will limit noise impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used* and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
