

## OUT OF HOURS NOTICE - NORTHBOURNE AVENUE

ANTILL-MOUAT STREET INTERSECTION TO ELOUERA- GOULD STREET INTERSECTION

6 - 14 JANUARY 2019

Canberra's first stage of Light Rail is progressing and construction is nearing completion. This is an exciting time in our City and Canberra Metro is working hard for Light Rail services to commence.

### **Construction Works:**

Out-of-hours works are required on Northbourne Avenue to:

- install street lights adjacent to the southbound lanes of Northbourne Avenue between Braddon and Dickson
- complete remaining kerb and footpath construction activities between Morphett and Murdoch Street median crossings at Lyneham.

The out-of-hours works will take place at night as and when required. As the works are scheduled for selected locations along the corridor, daily updates on when and where these works are taking place will be posted at [www.canberra-metro.com.au/updates](http://www.canberra-metro.com.au/updates).

The out-of-hours construction times will be 8:00pm to 6:00am between Sunday 6 and Monday 14 January.

### **Traffic Management and Detours:**

Generally this work will be undertaken in the median or adjacent verges and will only require lane reductions. For information on road closures and detours visit [www.canberra-metro.com.au/updates](http://www.canberra-metro.com.au/updates).

### **Additional Information:**

The equipment to be used includes: light towers, road saw, light vehicles, excavators, truck with hauling winch, elevated working platforms and vacuum trucks.

Due to the nature of the work, some of the activity will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
