

**OUT OF HOURS NOTICE - NORTHBOURNE AVENUE
ALINGA STREET
14 FEBRUARY – 15 MARCH 2018**

Canberra's first stage of Light Rail is progressing and construction is nearing completion. This is an exciting time in our City and Canberra Metro is working hard for Light Rail services to commence.

Construction Works:

Out-of-hours works are required to install new electrical conduit at the corners of Northbourne Avenue and Alinga Street. The work will take place **for four or five nights between Thursday 14 February and Friday 15 March between the hours of 8:00pm to 6:00am**. Traffic Management:

There will be no impacts to the road network. However, traffic management will be operational and highly visible throughout the works to ensure the safe passage of construction vehicles to and from the work site.

Additional Information:

The equipment to be used includes Light vehicles, excavators, vacuum trucks, road saw, light towers and compaction equipment.

The project team will ensure the number of machines operating at the same time is limited and equipment turned off when not in use. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used* and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.

These works are designed to transform Canberra, making it more accessible and to provide greater commuter connectivity across an integrated public transport network. We appreciate the continued patience of the public and the support of the Canberra community as we carry out these works.
