

OUT OF HOURS NOTICE - NORTHBOURNE AVENUE

ANTILL-MOUAT STREETS TO BARTON HIGHWAY INTERSECTION 15 AND 16 JULY 2018

Canberra's first stage of Light Rail is progressing and construction is well underway. This is an exciting time in our City and Canberra Metro is working hard to see this vision come to life.

Construction Works:

Additional out-of-hours work along Northbourne Avenue is required to complete kerb installation works at the Antill-Mouat Streets intersection. Out-of-hours work times for this extension period will be:

• between 8:00pm and 6:00am on Sunday 15 July. An additional night's work may be required on Monday 16 July to complete the program.

Traffic Management and Detours:

- The southbound lanes of Northbourne will be fully closed to motorists between the Antill-Mouat Streets intersection and the Barton Highway as per the dates above;
- Southbound detours will be in place via Barton Highway-Ellenborough Street and Phillip Avenue-Antill Street;

Traffic management will be in place and highly visible throughout the works, including signage and personnel.

Additional Information:

The equipment that will be used includes: road saw, excavator, light towers, compactor machinery, a hydrovac truck, light vehicles and trucks.

Due to the nature of the work, some of the activities will be noisy. The project team will limit noise impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used* and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.


Are you Rail Ready?
