

**OUT OF HOURS NOTICE NORTHBOURNE AVENUE**  
ELOUERA-GOULD STREETS INTERSECTION TO  
MASSON-GIRRAHWEEN STREETS INTERSECTION  
**12-15 OCTOBER**

Construction of the first stage of the Light Rail between Gungahlin and the City nearing completion. During the final stage of the project Canberra Metro will maintain every effort to ensure minimal disruption to the public as works continue.

**Construction Works:**

Overhead wire will be installed on Northbourne Avenue from the Elouera-Gould Streets intersection, through to the Masson –Girrahween Streets intersection. The work will take place during out-of-hours to minimise road user disruption. Work will take place from **10:00pm Friday 12 October until 6:00am Monday 15 October.**

**Traffic Management and Detours:**

Between 10:00pm Friday and 6:00am Monday, both intersections will be closed periodically. The traffic changes in place during these closures will include:

- **No right-turn** into Elouera Street from Northbourne Avenue
- **No right turn** into Gould Street from Northbourne Avenue
- **No right turn** onto Northbourne Avenue from Elouera or Gould Streets
- **No right-turn** into Masson Street from Northbourne Avenue
- **No right-turn** into Girrahween Street from Northbourne Avenue
- **No right turn** onto Northbourne Avenue from Masson and Girrahween Streets
- **Lane reductions** on Northbourne Avenue during off-peak periods at these intersections, but through traffic along Northbourne Avenue will be maintained.

Traffic management and detour signage highly visible throughout the works.

**Additional Information:**

The equipment in use will be an excavator, elevated work platform, trucks, road saws and light vehicles.

There will be increased noise levels due to the nature of this work. The project team will limit these noise impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used\* and workers have been instructed to keep noise to a minimum.

***These works are designed to transform Canberra, making it more accessible and to provide greater commuter connectivity across an integrated public transport network. We appreciate the continued patience of the public and the support of the Canberra community as we carry out these works.***
